




Hello actors!

We are extremely excited for the audition process for ***The Addams Family (A New Musical Comedy)***. This is guaranteed to be an extremely fun show and we cannot wait to see what everyone brings to the auditions!

Auditions will be on **December 14th-15th**. Follow the directions below to prepare:

1. Complete your [Audition form](#).
 - a. Make sure to answer all questions and to read through the schedule carefully. List all conflicts, including complete details about any reason you may miss rehearsal during the process. While we will honor any conflicts listed on the audition form should you be cast, an *occasional* excused absence is acceptable for scheduled appointments/voice lessons/ect. around rehearsals. However, it is imperative for you to be at every rehearsal possible, especially as we learn new choreography, songs, blocking, etc. and as we get closer to performance. Your peers are depending on you to be consistent and reliable!
2. Read through the [Synopsis and Character Breakdown](#) to get an idea of the show, the characters, and their vocal ranges to help you decide which musical cuts and monologue to prepare for auditions. Addams Family members each have their own iconic personalities, which we'd like to see, but put your own spin on it to bring it to life! It would be worth looking into video clips to discover those personalities.



3. Prepare ONE monologue from this [list](#). Choose a character you are passionate about performing and please develop them fully for your audition. Showcase what makes you able to play a particular character. Remember, the more fun you have with it, the more fun we will have watching you!

4. Prepare your dance audition using [the direction videos in this folder](#) (make sure to learn the appropriate dance for your gender) and choose TWO music cuts from [this folder](#) to prepare.

5. Make sure to reserve [a sign up slot!](#)
Plan to be available 15 minutes before your slot and 15 minutes after just in case we are running ahead or behind. We will ask that you do your song cuts first, followed by your monologue, and finishing with your dance cut. Make sure to practice a slate introducing the song cuts you will be doing in the order you'd like to perform as well as the character of the monologue you have chosen to prepare.



6. Here is the [TENTATIVE REHEARSAL SCHEDULE](#) for the show in case you need quick access to it. Make sure to note: **Callbacks will be on December 15th from 12-4 and our first read through will be on December 17th from 12:00-4:00.**
7. **Additional Help:** If anyone is struggling with the Gomez musical cut, Ms. Timmons is amazing and created a practice track for you to help guide you. It can be found [here](#). Also, if you are singing the Morticia musical cut, you can use either the lyrics from the sheet music or from the book. Whatever works best for you!
