Valor Christian High School contracts with FACTS management company to help us administer our tuition assistance program. If you would like to be considered for tuition assistance for the 2020-2021 academic year, please read the following information carefully. Our Philosophy

Valor welcomes students from a variety of backgrounds who, along with their parents, are excited to engage in our school community. Funds are distributed according to demonstrated need, with no requirement for repayment. We consider certain financial choices to be within your control and therefore not valid reasons to claim financial need. For example:

- A parent's voluntary unemployment without a significant reason
- Sibling enrollment in another private school or college, or parent pursuit of an advanced degree
- Avoidance of tapping into investment assets or savings accounts
- High debt, credit card balances or expenses associated with luxury vehicles, homes, vacations, sport activities or lifestyle habits
- Other lifestyle choices or tax exemption strategies that reduce cash flow or preserve capital investments

Our desire is to provide a Valor education to students for whom our school is an excellent fit and whose families are challenged with genuine financial strain. We trust that all applying families are in alignment with this philosophy, have carefully evaluated their financial circumstance, and are moving forward with integrity.

Get Started Early

If you believe you are a good candidate for tuition assistance, we encourage you to begin your *FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment (FGAA)* application as soon as possible — regardless of whether your student has been admitted or re-enrolled. Please note that you do not need to have your final tax or financial statements to begin an application; there are plenty of opportunities to upload your financial records throughout the application process.

We are honored to award more than \$2 million in tuition assistance, in aggregate, to approximately 25 percent of our students. As a result, the process for each individual applicant can take several months. We strongly encourage all our applying families to begin their application no later than February 1, 2020. If you are enrolling a new student, please note that your enrollment deposit is fully refundable in the event that Valor is unable to award the full amount of your stated need and you decline enrollment.
