

Shadow Day Frequently Asked Questions

Shadowing at a new school can be intimidating – don't let that stop you from spending part of a day experiencing student life with us. Here's some important information to help make your day go smoothly:

Where do I meet my ambassador?

Students will be greeted in the main lobby of the Academic Building by Karen Kay and Jeannette Roberts and ambassadors will come to meet them.

When are Shadow Days?

Shadow Days are typically on select Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

What time should I arrive?

Please arrive by 8:50 am.

What should I bring?

You do not need anything, but you are welcome to bring a book in the event that your ambassador has a quiz or test.

May I bring my cell phone?

You may have your cell phone, but students are not allowed to have them out during class time.

Is there a dress code?

We do not have a uniform, but we appreciate when our shadow students model our dress code. This is defined as modest dress, no gym type clothing, no earrings on boys, and no hats. Leggings are permissible with a long top. Thank you for respecting the culture of our school.

How long is a shadow day?

Students are available for pickup at 1:30 pm.

Do I need to bring a lunch?

Can my parents tour the campus?

Yes, we offer campus tours on select Tuesdays from 1:00-2:30 p.m. and select Thursdays from 9:15-10:45 a.m.
